



Swine Flu Management

Plan for managing the spread of flu and the distribution of information:

The absence of accurate and managed information will be uncontrolled information, speculation and fear based on rumours and xenophobia. At Bond we will:

1. Share our plan with all stakeholders of Bond Academy & Bond International College.
2. Provide tangible and visible indicators of our plan:
 - Providing information of our plan to parents and students.
 - Hand sanitizers at each entrance with an accompanying sign.
 - Hand sanitizers at the entrance and exit from cafeteria.
 - Maintain plentiful supply of quality liquid soap and paper towels in all washrooms.
 - Washrooms monitored at least 3 times daily for supplies of soap and for spot cleaning.
3. Signs in each washroom re hand-washing
4. Signs in each classroom re hand-washing
5. Provide staff with handout from Health Canada.
6. Teachers provide students with age appropriate information, focusing on prevention as opposed to severity and the fear associated with contacting the flu.
7. Update staff regularly as required via the email communication.
8. Communicate to parents via email and via hard copy our plan for minimizing risk of contacting flu in our school environment.
9. Be proactive in adjusting the correct & important messages to all stakeholders of Bond Academy & Bond International College.
